Here's what you'll need:*

Passport

Residency Documentation, please provide at least one of the following government-issued documents:

- Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant (F-1) Student Status, Form I-20
- Certificate of Eligibility for Exchange Visitor (J-1) Status, Form DS-2019
- Arrival/Departure Record, Form I-94
- Form I-797 (H-1B1), I-797A and I-797B
- Form I-765 Approval Letter/Employment Authorization Card

Student ID card (if available)

Completed W-8 BEN tax form, available at [IRS.gov/FormW8BEN](https://www.irs.gov/FormW8BEN)

NOTE: A written explanation is required when a U.S. Address or Phone is provided on a W-8BEN form.

Funds you wish to deposit

NOTE: A \$5 opening deposit is required. This establishes your membership (or ownership) in MSUFCU. If you apply online, you can make the opening deposit by visiting a branch, mailing a check, or through an electronic transfer from another financial institution.
