FACTS WHAT DOES CRESCENT TITLE DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why? Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some, but not all, sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What? The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- Wire Transfer Instructions and assets
- Mortgage rates and payments and credit scores

How? All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their businesses. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information, the reasons Crescent Title chooses to share, and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do

How does Crescent Title protect my personal information? To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with state and federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does Crescent Title collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: • Visit our website or fill out an online form • Provide your information or request a third party to send us information • Order for title insurance We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: • Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes — information about your creditworthiness • Affiliates from using your information to market to you • Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • Our affiliates include nonfinancial companies such as MSUFCU, Reseda Group LLC, and other entities such as MSUFCU Desk Drawer Foundation.
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • Nonaffiliates we share with can include financial companies such as insurance companies and other companies such as nonprofit organizations.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. • Our joint marketing partners include insurance companies, investment partners, and other financial service companies.
